About Us

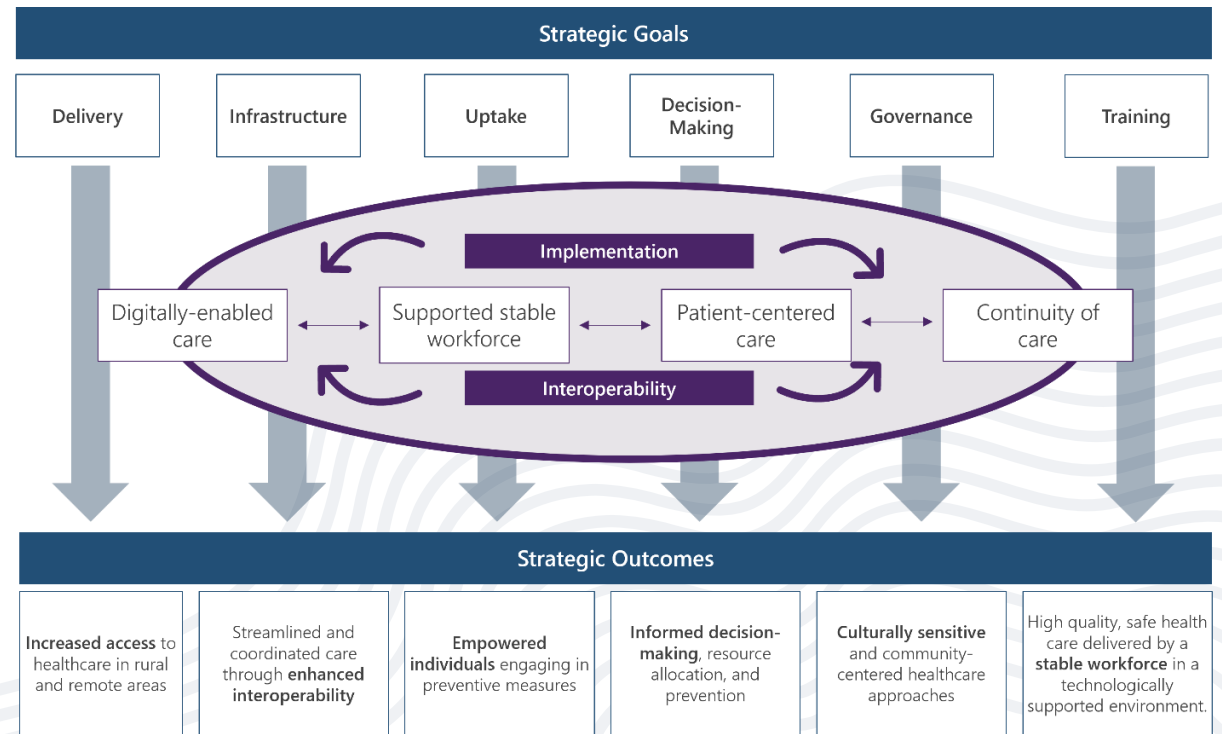
